FERPA: Clarification of the interplay of the disclosures required under the "Clery Act" and the prohibition against the disclosure of information from education records contained in the "Family Education Rights and Privacy Act" (FERPA) provides no barrier to compliance with the disclosures under "Clery Act". The reporting of crime statistics by an institution of the occurrence of crimes on campus does not violate FERPA. FERPA protects the nonconsensual disclosure of personally identifiable information from education records: FERPA does not protect statistical information. FERPA does not preclude an institution's compliance with timely warning provision of the "Clery Act." Information can, in case of an emergency, be released without consent when needed to protect health and safety of others (34 C.F.R. Section 99.31(b)(6) & 99.36). The "Clery" Act amended FERPA to allow institution to disclose to the victim of an alleged crime of violence the results of a disciplinary proceeding brought against a student accused of the crime. Without prior consent of the accused. This disclosure is limited to the alleged victim who should be informed that the information may not be disclosed to the general public (20 U.S.C. Section 1232g(b)(6)).
